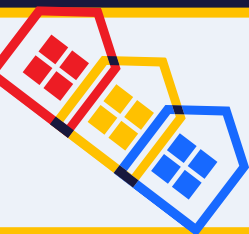
Stigma

- ✓ Training the community in overdose prevention, harm reduction methods, person-centered language & Support educating the public that recovery is a valuable asset to the community



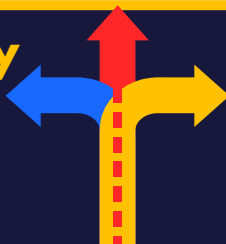
Housing

Recovery over Party

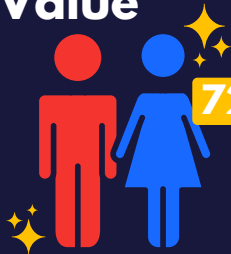
42%

Recovery Value

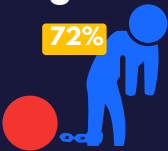
72%

Recovery Access

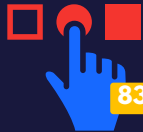
62%
